In 1910, he was living with his widowed mother and brothers in Mooresville at age 37.




After moving to Sweeny in 1911, apparently he went back to Daviess, Missouri to marry Esther Barlow.

James was the owner of the two story Reynolds & Reynolds general merchandise & grocery (also known as "The Square Deal Store"), 6 in the 1917 Main Street picture below. Main & 2nd, SE corner.

Charlene Finley: Mr. Reynolds was known for helping local graduates with college loans during my time in high school; I think he wrote an obituary of Dr. Eades.




SWEENY IN 1919
